PAGEANT APPLICATIONS

North Platte will be host to the 54th Miss Rodeo Nebraska Pageant and the 4th Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska Pageant to be held June 14—17 during the NEBRASKAland Days –Buffalo Bill Rodeo Celebration in North Platte.

Applicants for the Miss Rodeo Nebraska Pageant must be unmarried women who are not less than 19 years of age nor more than 24 years of age at the time of competition for the title of Miss Rodeo America in December of 2009. Applicant for the Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska Pageant must be entering the 9th—12th grade the fall semester after the pageant.

Contestants for both pageants will be judged by three experienced judges and will compete in three main categories—Horsemanship, Personality, and Appearance. Horsemanship will require completion of two different horsemanship patterns. Personality will be judged during a live speech written by each contestant focusing on her hometown, several personal interviews with questions ranging from horsemanship and rodeo to current events and more, and impromptu questions in public settings. Appearance will be judged during all phases of the competition in regard to appropriate western dress and how the contestant conveys her personality through her appearance. Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska 2009 will be crowned Wednesday morning, June 17, at the Queen's Breakfast. Miss Rodeo Nebraska 2010 will be crowned during the June 17th Wednesday evening performance of the Buffalo Bill Rodeo. Winners and runners-up of both crowns will receive scholarships and awards.
